Varietal Notes: Müller-Thurgau (Mew-ler Tur-gow) was created by Swiss viticulturist Hermann Müller in 1882, by crossing Riesling and Madeleine Royale (a table grape).

Tasting Notes: This Müller-Thurgau is similar to a dry German Riesling. The nose offers clean citrus and tropical fruit aromas as well as carrot cake and spice. The palate shows crisp and zesty flavors of apple and white peach and mineral notes of flint.
